Carmelo Mesa-Lago is Distinguished Service Professor Emeritus of Economics at the University of Pittsburgh; a visiting professor/ researcher in 7 countries and lecturer in 39; author of 94 books and 318 articles/chapters published in 9 languages in 34 countries, most of them on social security including pensions, his most recent book is *Evaluation of Four Decades of Pension Privatization in Latin America 1980-2020;* consultant in all Latin American countries and 8 more in the world; member of the US National Academy of Social Insurance and the Board of *International Social Security Review;* ILO International Prize on Decent Work (shared with Nelson Mandela).
